Given that we break for the Easter Holiday this week, I thought it would be a good idea to provide you with a suggested kit list for the Bushcraft Trip schedule for 24-26 May 2023

With this in mind, The Bushcraft Company kindly provide us with the following kit list:

The essentials:

- Large rucksack or holdall
- Small rucksack to carry your essentials
- Warm sleeping bag (season 3 recommended)
- Roll mat
- Tracksuit or hardwearing trousers
- T-shirts
- Jumper or fleece
- Waterproof jacket and trousers
- Socks and underwear
- 2 pairs of footwear e.g. walking boots/old trainers
- Wash bag including toothbrush, toothpaste, soap and face wipes
- Towels
- Suitable footwear
- Water bottle or hydration system
- Alcohol hand gel
- Insect repellent
- Torch (with fresh batteries) - a head torch is ideal

Optional extras:

- Whistle
- Plastic bags for dirty/wet clothing/footwear
- Sleeping bag liner
- Pillow and pillowcase

Weather dependant items:


- Wellington boots
