Help our Community Woodland grow with more tree planting!



You are invited to join us for an hour or so between 10am and 2.30pm on Saturday 25th November, on what will be **Cherry Fields Tree Planting Day No.3**. The 2000 trees planted by residents last Autumn and in the Spring are doing amazingly well but now it's time to plant some more!

Who can come? Anyone who wants to help! If you can't dig holes, you can help with tree mats, stakes or tree guards. Children will be very welcome but **must** be accompanied by an adult.

What will I need? Your own spade (ideally narrow bladed); a 2-3lb lump hammer if you have one; warm clothing; wellies or boots - and enthusiasm! We will carry on whatever the weather!

What else do I need to know? Cherry Fields are south of Fiskerton Rd, near the end of Laburnum Drive. There is no parking on site but the landlord of the Cherry Tree pub is very happy for you to use the car park there. The main gate is opposite no 29 Fiskerton Rd. (Please take great care when crossing the road!) You will need to follow the main path down to the bottom field; this time we will be planting trees within the loops of ground formed by the bike track. The Oasis will provide coffee in the morning and soup in the afternoon and will also kindly allow us the use of their compostable toilet!

What do I have to do if I want to take part? Just turn up with your spade, sign in (we keep a log of volunteer hours to support grant applications) and find our tree expert, Nigel!
