Dear Parents/Carers,

It is with great pleasure that we write to you regarding your child's first Module Report at Pembroke.

Your child will receive an Attitude to Learning (AtL) report, two Priory Trust reports and a written report during the academic year. These reports will be published through the SIMs Parent App.

This module, your child will receive AtL grades for each subject. These are determined by the extent to which your child embodies our school rules: Be Ready; Be Safe; Be Respectful. Each of the three rules will receive a grade for each subject your child studies. The highest mark on each scale is 'Always', followed by 'Often', then 'Sometimes', and finally, 'Rarely'. This provides an accurate picture of your child's attitude, conduct and organisation across all their subjects over the course of a module 1 and 2. The criteria for assessing attitude to learning for each rule are shown in the attached document.

In Module 3 and 6, you will receive a more in-depth report which provides an indication of the academic standard your child is currently working at in each subject. Each attainment grade has also been mapped to an indicative grade we may expect from your child at GCSE level if they continue to progress at their current rate. The scale for these marks is below.

Key Stage 3 attainment grades	Approximate GCSE Grade Boundary
WTS (Working towards)	1-3
EXS(F) (Expected Foundation)	4
EXS(E) (Expected Established)	5-6
GDS (Greater Depths)	7-9

Finally, in Module 6, you will also receive a comprehensive written report for your child. This will include AtL and attainment grades, a written report from your child's form tutor, as well as a breakdown of strengths and weaknesses in both knowledge and skills in each subject. This will help you to better understand the next steps your child needs to take to progress in their learning, as well as inform you of any additional support you may be able to provide at home.

Finally, you will have an opportunity to discuss your child's progress with their subject teachers at **Year 7 Parents Evening on Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> March 2026**.
