Here at The Priory Pembroke Academy we work in conjunction with Lincolnshire County Council and their Stay Safe Partnership. They provide schools with a "Stay Safe Day" programme which aims to improve personal safety by making students aware of the consequence of their actions on themselves, their families and the community. These days fully support our Personal Development Curriculum that is delivered through "Life" as well as assemblies and form time activities.

This year the programme will be delivered to our Year 8 students on Wednesday 3rd May 2023 and Year 10 students on Wednesday 10th May 2023.

The workshops are delivered by a variety of agencies including Lincolnshire Road Safety Partnership, We Are With You, Lincolnshire Safeguarding Children Board, Lincolnshire Police, Lincolnshire Fire Service and Lincolnshire County Council.

The programme has had some excellent feedback from students because it does not tell them what to do, but gives them the facts and safety tips about the subject and raises awareness about what could happen if they take certain steps.

Some of the information is hard hitting and there are photos and videos which we and the Stay Safe Partnership think are suitable for Year 8 &10 students, however, we recognise that some students may be sensitive to them due to personal experience or circumstances. The Stay Safe Partnership will liaise with school in advance to show us the content of these to ascertain if we feel any students may be affected.
