

Dear Year 11 Parents and Carers

Congratulations Students on an excellent first week of remote learning. Over 80% of students have engaged with live lessons, demonstrating their passion and curiosity, and all staff want to congratulate you on your ready, respectful and safe attitude to these sessions.

We have been working hard to resolve technical issues encountered due to the volume of use of the Teams and Citrix applications. To remedy this in the short term, we would advise that you access the live Teams lessons within the web browser on your device or by downloading the app rather than in Citrix for a more stable connection. You can access Teams at <u>teams.microsoft.com</u> on your device and use your school email address to log in. Then if you go to your Teams calendar by clicking on the 3 dots on the top-left of the pane, then select Calendar to view your Teams lessons scheduled by your teacher and you can join the lessons from there. Students should continue to access all other home learning through Citrix as normal.

Please can we remind students that they will only be allowed to join the meeting if they have been invited and are using their school account. This means that access will not be granted by the member of staff hosting the lesson if the link is sent to a different email or parents' Teams account.

The Live lesson timetable for the week beginning 11th January is attached to this letter. Please remember that 'live' sessions have been designed to support you in your home learning as set through the 'Home Learning' area of SharePoint not as a replacement for this work. If you do not have a timetabled live lesson, please use your time to complete the independent learning tasks. All live lessons will be recorded. The lesson may be shared with students unable to attend the live session. The recordings will not and must not be shared outside of the academy or on any form of social media.

To make the live lessons as effective as possible, we are asking students to limit their use of the chat feature based on the instructions of the teacher. Very clear guidelines will be issued to students in the next few days. If a student behaves disrespectfully during live lesson, either in the chat feature or by causing a disruption to the delivery they will be removed from the live lesson and parents/carers will be contacted.
