I am writing to inform you of a matter of utmost importance regarding a recent declaration by the UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA) regarding measles as a national incident.

Measles is a highly infectious disease that can have severe consequences, including pneumonia, meningitis, and, in rare cases, long-term disability or death. It is crucial to note that measles is a vaccine-preventable disease, and the most effective way to safeguard against its infection is by receiving two doses of the MMR Vaccine.

I want to ensure that you are well-informed about this situation, and to assist with that, I have attached a bulletin provided by David Clark, the Public Health Programme Manager at Lincolnshire County Council. The bulletin is designed for parents and/or carers, and I encourage you to review it carefully.
