Then if finished complete activity 2 on Bitesize: CAD and CAM advantages and disadvantages. This continues on from what we have learnt about CAD from the Beach Hut project and help you understand CAM (Computer Aided manufacture). Investigative activity- How can we take a traditional material, such as paper and improve its strength at home? The power point that goes with this activity can be located on the technology area of <u>sharepoint</u>.
