Task 1 – Live Theatre Evaluation

Please log onto BCC iPlayer. (you will need an account in order to watch, however they are completely free to create, and your household must have a TV license).

You are to watch 2 different episodes from 'The Goes Wrong Show'. For each episode, you are to complete the questions outlined in the booklet, reviewing the performance.

- What have they done well?
- What could they do to improve the performance if they were to create it again?
- Explain in detail how comedy has been created for an audience.
- Identify the different physical movements that have been used and how they are effective for the performance being created.

Task 2 – The Imp Trail 'Visual Storytelling'.

You are to research the legend of the Lincoln Imp – as outlines in Mrs Warnock's assembly. Using this, you are to come up with a short story that can be turned into a performance / piece of script, demonstrating an area of originality.

TASK 2

Create an A-Z glossary of ICT Key words

This should be produced as an **interactive PPT Presentation**, using your hyperlink and action button skills.

You will need to access the website using Google Chrome browser otherwise the site might not work.

Click on VOCABULARY UNITS and then complete exercises in the section MA CHAMBRE. You can also practise the past tense in SECOND YEAR LEARNING (ENCORE TRICOLORE 2) completing exercises in the section LES QUESTIONS AU PASSE COMPOSE (UNITE 5). You can also revise different topics by choosing in TOPIC UNITS and completing exercises in FIRST YEAR LEARNING REVISION and SECOND YEAR LEARNING REVISION.

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- 1. Explore the 'rules of composition' in terms of photography and take a photo to show each rule present these as a ppt and annotate each one explaining the rules. (7 Rules are: fill the frame, creative framing, rule of thirds, leading lines, foreground & depth, odd numbers, contrasting colours)
- 2. If you opt for photography your first project will be the Alphabet project google this and have a go at it with objects inside and outside your house which resemble the letter forms of the English alphabet. Save these onto a ppt and your phone/camera because you can use these in year 10 if you do opt. Using ppt shrink your photo's and spell the school value words with them. If you can edit them using an app (such as Adobe photoshop express) then you can add filters too and have a play with the effects.
- 3. Complete the 30 day drawing challenge for year 9 (attached).

echnology

Create an information help guide about electrical components, the symbols used to represent them, as well as the function of the components. Draw some examples of circuits using the symbols you have researched. Then research the following and add them to your information guide;

- What is a PCB?
- What is soldering?
- What equipment should be used when soldering?
- What safety precautions should be taken?
