English	<p>Work through the revision booklets for each literature text and complete past papers for English language. Email any responses to Mr Dominy for marking.</p>

Drama	<p>When a piece of work is completed, please send it over via email so that I can look over it and provide you feedback.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Students are to work through the Component 1 revision booklet, where there are a number of different activities for you to complete. These are aimed at Section 1, however the skills are transferrable to the entire written paper. 2. Blood Brothers Revision – students are to work through the extensive revision guide that has been provided in physical form, as well as on the SharePoint page. You should make notes on the content covered and ensure that you know and understand the context, themes and key moments. 3. Live Theatre Evaluation – students are to work through the Live Theatre Evaluation booklet, focusing on Billy Elliot (which was watched in lesson). You should aim to complete as many of the activities as possible, as this will aid in your overall understanding of the play and how it has been created for the stage. 4. Mock Papers – a number of mock papers are included. It is vital that you complete them (ideally in the allowed time frame) <p>Revision tips:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Listen to the soundtrack – this can be done on Apple Music, YouTube, Spotify. 2. Read the text – be sure that you are familiar with the text as you could be asked to write about a section from anywhere in the play – this will make finding the section a lot easier. 3. Geography	<p>Work through the Ecosystems section of the Edexcel A Workbook and cross reference your answers with the answers in the back of the workbook. Make any improvements to incorrect or incomplete work. If complete, go onto Changing Cities and Global Development sections of the workbook.</p>

History	<p>GCSE - Revision of core content, Flash cards work very well for this. Copies of knowledge organisers are on the History Sharepoint page.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make sure you know the Chronology of events for each paper. ESPECIALLY AMERICAN WEST. Create timelines, put events on card then place them in the correct order, identify links between events (narrative Q in AW, continuity and Change for Crime) • Check understanding of key vocabulary • Complete workbooks and other revision activities available on Sharepoint. • Complete practice questions and past papers under timed conditions. • READ READ READ– check the reading list on Sharepoint and do extra reading to expand your knowledge. Books can be borrowed from Mrs Warnock. • Watch recommended documentaries/youtube clips (see the reading list and links on Sharepoint)

MFL	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Use your photocopies with the answers for the general conversation of the speaking exam (remember, you have to learn them by heart). 2. Complete the Booklets for main vocabulary (photocopies provided) that could be found in reading and listening exams.
Art	<p>Your exam is looming – therefore you need to continue to prepare your individual prep work towards your final piece. Should you need practical media/materials – then focus on creating more quality observational drawings which link to your theme.</p>
Technology	<p>Your exam is looming – therefore you need to continue to revise. Focus on revising the core content</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Timbers- Oak, Mahogany, beech, balsa, pine cedar, plywood, MDF, Jultong, birch, ash, larch and chipboard • Polymers • card and paper • fibres and textiles • smart materials and composite materials • metals • electronics systems • mechanical devices (pulleys, levers, gears and cams). • Energy: generation, storage and sources • Communication techniques (drawing styles- especially practice drawing the following; isometric, oblique, one point perspective, two point, orthographic- 1st and 3rd angle, and circuit diagrams) <p>Create yourself revision resources for the sections above you know you struggle with e.g. flash cards (with questions on one side and answers on the back) and memory maps (like a mind map of what you remember then look up the bits you forgot and add them to it in a different colour).</p> <p>Use BBC bite size design technology (Edexcel) to help and technologystudent.com (has practice sheets for all the content in all the topics)</p>
