

Pembroke Spanish Curriculum Map

Year 7

Students in year 7 start Spanish learning to talk about themselves and then opening to the world around them. They learn greetings, describing themselves and their families (physical descriptions and personalities), pets, opinions, numbers, free time activities, seasons, subjects and school life, describing a city and ordering in a Spanish restaurant. They learn to use the present tense and they get introduced to the Near Future tense.

Year 8

Students in year 8 learn to describe a past holiday (using the Preterite tense), hobbies, TV programmes and music, food and ordering in a restaurant, daily routines (how to get ready and clothes), future plans such as describing holiday accommodation, things that you can do during a holiday and directions.

Students learn to use the conditional tense, and the preterite (simple past) tense, as well as using the present tense.

Year 9

Students in year 9 learn about their likes and opinions regarding films and hobbies and ways to celebrate special events such as birthdays. They learn about jobs; things you do in different jobs and what job you'd like to do. Healthy lifestyle and habits, including food and daily routines. Different nationalities, children rights and the environment describing what you can do around the city of Madrid, its culture and buying souvenirs, etc.

Students learn to use the Near Future tense and consolidate using 3 tenses together.

Year 10

Pearson Edexcel GCSE Spanish

Students learn and practice the 4 language skills (reading, listening, writing and speaking) through different thematic contexts:

My personal world and media and technology: sports, life online, free-time activities, different families, who you follow on social media, friendships and relationships and your own identity. **Travel and tourism:** discussing travel plans, holidays and accommodation, including talking about festivals in the Spanish-speaking world. **Lifestyle and wellbeing:** learning about typical foods, healthy daily routines, mealtimes and food trends, illnesses and injuries and future plans for health and wellbeing. **Studying and my future:** School life in Spain, your studies, talking about students and teachers at school. **My neighbourhood:** describing cities and how a city or town has changed, describing shopping preferences and giving preferences and comparisons about where you live, describing your area.

Year 11

Pearson Edexcel GCSE Spanish

Students learn and practice the 4 language skills (reading, listening, writing and speaking) through different thematic contexts:

Environment: learning about natural wonders of Spanish-speaking countries, talking about how you help in your community, talking about climate change and actions to help the environment, talking about social and climate issues

Studying and my future: Learning about your hopes and dreams and different ways to express future plans, talking about future career intentions.

Applying and developing skills and techniques to prepare students to use Spanish in real-life situations. Developing effective comprehension skills and consolidating knowledge.
